How to play:

1. Make conveniently-sized groups
2. Decide the order of the groups
3. The first group sends a representative to the front.
4. The student spins to select a feeling and picks a card with a word/phrase on it. S/he reads the card with feeling (twice).
5. The student's group attempts to guess the feeling.  
If the group fails, the next group may attempt it (and so on).
6. The student's group attempts to guess what was said.  
If the group fails, the next group may attempt it (and so on).
7. The student's group attempts to guess the English meaning.  
If the group fails, the next group may attempt it (and so on).
8. The next group sends a representative to the front.

Play continues until one group scores 20 points or time is up.
